<u>Anderson Natural Medicine – Financial Agreement</u> Naturopathic Medical Visits

Know your insurance benefits

- All patients and their financially responsible parties/guardians are responsible for knowing the patient's insurance benefits. It is recommended that you know your coverage before receiving medical care.
- Your insurance policy is a contract between you and your insurance company.
- Our office and billing company may check your benefits as a courtesy to you. We are not responsible for their final payment or any misquoted information. Your insurance company does not guarantee payment until a claim is processed.
- If Dr. Anderson is a provider associated with your insurance company, we will bill your insurance company, however, all charges for services, medications, laboratory testing and imaging are the responsibility of the patient or legal guardian.

Fees for Service

Dr. Anderson is a provider with Regence, Premera and Lifewise, and First Choice Health insurance companies; however, **this does not guarantee payment by your insurance company**. Your individual policy may or may not cover naturopathic office visits or they may cover them only within certain networks. Patients are responsible for all charges that are not covered by their insurance, including the office visit, tests, any procedure done in office, as well as any substances used in any procedure.

- Homeopathic injectable substances and B12 injections ARE NOT covered by most personal health insurance policies. The cost of injectable substances will be collected at the time of the office visit as well as any copay or coinsurance, with the exception of Botox or Xeomin for migraine injections. By signing this financial agreement you agree to waive billing of homeopathic injectable materials and B12 injections to your insurance company.
- If Dr. Anderson is not in-network with your insurance company, fees are due at the time of service. You may submit your bill for reimbursement by your insurance.
- External Labs and Specialty Lab companies may bill your insurance for your convenience. If they do not accept insurance payments, you are responsible for the costs associated with the testing.

Cancellations for Naturopathic Medical Appointments

Cancellations for medical appointments require 24 hours notification, via telephone call to our office at 425-429-2334. If less than 24 hours notification is given, a \$50 cancellation fee will be charged to your patient account. **If you do not provide any notice of cancellation**, **a "no-show" fee** will be applied to your patient account up to the full cost of the office visit. These fees are not reimbursable by your insurance company.

Unpaid Balances

Balances that remain unpaid after 30 days may be subject to additional interest at 1% per month (12%APR). Balances that are deemed uncollectable by our office will incur additional collection fees and will be referred to a collection specialty company which may affect your credit.
